# RECAP

In this fifth sermon walking through the story of Jesus' life and ministry, Josh discussed the last supper Jesus celebrated with his disciples and the two bombshells Jesus dropped that changed everything!

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Today's message centered around the last supper Jesus had with his disciples before his death. As Christians today we celebrate it as the Lord's Supper (or Communion). In your faith journey, what has the Lord's Supper meant to you? How often did you celebrate it as a church?
- 2. Read Luke 22:19. Jesus shocked his disciples when he told them that from now on the Passover would be celebrated in his honor. This shocked them because Jesus was changing a religious tradition that had been in place for 1500 years. Even today, people don't like change. What are some of the hardest changes in life you've had to deal with? How do you think the disciples must have felt hearing Jesus' shocking statements?
- 3. Read Luke 22:20. Jesus came to fulfill the old covenant God made with Israel and replace it with something better. Instead of a conditional covenant Jesus established an unconditional covenant through his death on the cross. If you're a parent, talk about your unconditional love for your kids and how that mirrors God's love towards you. What could your kids do to make you stop loving them? What can you do to make God stop loving you?
- 4. Read John 13:33-35. Jesus replaced the 600+ commandments in the Old Testament with one new commandment, the command to love one another. Instead of earning God's favor, we have it once and for all through Jesus. How much of your religious life do you tend to spend worrying about whether God is pleased with you? How does this new covenant and new command change that?

#### **NEXT STEP**

The command to love each other as Christ loves us still stands as our marching orders today. As a group, what are some practical ways you can show Christ's love to each other this week?
