


JESUS SAID WHAT!?! Week 3: Candy/Cancer DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

RECAP

In this third sermon discussing some of the more confusing and controversial teachings of Jesus, we looked at a confusing discourse Jesus taught about money that actually revealed a much deeper importance to giving than we normally give it.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

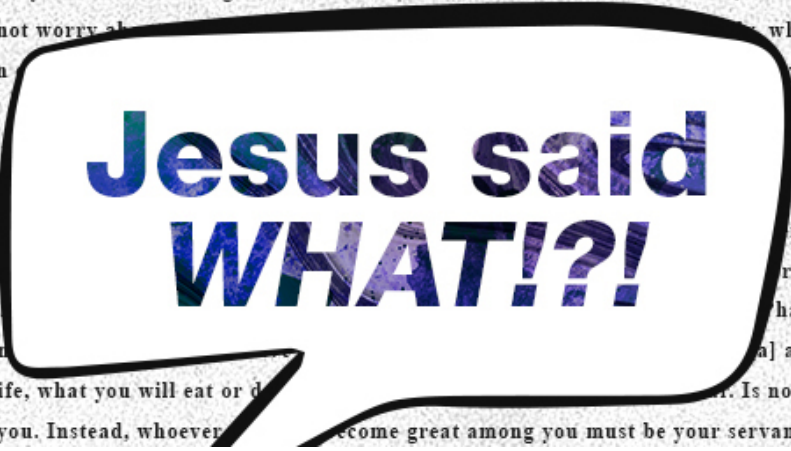
1. Josh started by talking about Halloween candy, how some is good but too much can lead to negative consequences (like cavities). What are some other things that you enjoy that you have to be careful to enjoy in moderation? (Hobbies, food, relationships, etc.)
2. Read Matthew 6:19-20 where Jesus tells us to store up for ourselves treasures in heaven. What are three or four examples of what it practically means to store up treasures on earth vs storing up treasures in heaven?
3. Look at the BIG Idea for the week (Message Notes). Josh made the argument that money is the onramp to your heart, because where you spend your money, your heart follows. Do you agree? Talk about some of the things you are the most passionate about? Do they line up with where you spend your money?
4. Read Matthew 6:22-23 and the comparison Josh made between money and cancer. Do you tend to think of balancing money and God like too much candy (not that serious) or like stage four cancer (very serious)? What happens if we're not careful with how we interact with money and we let the cancer of greed and selfishness run rampant in our hearts?
5. Look at the Three Ways to Live Generously (Message Notes). What is one or two practical ways you are living generously in each of the three areas?

NEXT STEP

As a group, talk about which one of the Three Ways to Live Generously that you are the weakest in and something you can do together as a group to take a next step towards generosity.
